Types of data processed</p>	<p>Consorzio Nazionale Interuniversitario per le Telecomunicazioni (CNIT) processes personal data belonging to the following categories of interested parties:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - consortium employees; - related, associated and affiliated personnel; - holders of external collaboration contracts (e.g. cococo, professional collaborations, etc.); - CNIT scholarship holders; - other external subjects participating in events organized by the Consortium. <p>In particular, the following are treated:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - personal data (name, surname); - audio, video or photographic material in which the interested party appears represented or is in any case recognizable ("portrait").
<p>3. Source of personal data</p>	<p>Personal data in the possession of the Consortium is collected directly from the persons concerned.</p>
<p>4. Purpose of processing and legal basis</p>	<p>The data being processed are collected and used for the publication and/or dissemination of the portrait of the interested party for the purpose of institutional communication and promotion of the image of the National Inter-University Consortium for Telecommunications.</p> <p>The publication/dissemination of the portrait can take place:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) on sites belonging to the CNIT Web system (for example, on the CNIT institutional site www.cnit.it and on other subdomains (e.g. CNIT National Research Laboratories or research project sites managed by CNIT); 2) on the social channels used by the CNIT Consortium (for example, Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, Telegram, YouTube, ecc.); 3) on printed paper and/or on any other means of dissemination/publication (for example, web publications, blogs, etc.); 4) in promotional banners on poster paper, floor lamps, advertisements, information materials, brochures and leaflets.

	<p>Consent to the processing will be collected by completing this form pursuant to articles 10 and 320 of the Civil Code and articles 96 and 97 of Law 633/1941 – Copyright Law and may be revoked at any time by writing to the address direction@cnit.it. Pursuant to Article 96 L. 633/1941, the portrait of a person cannot be exhibited, reproduced or put on the market without the person's consent unless the conditions provided for in Article 97 which provide that no the consent of the person portrayed is required when the reproduction of the image is justified by notoriety or the public office held, by justice or police needs, by scientific, educational or cultural purposes, or when the reproduction is connected to facts, events, ceremonies of public interest or held in public. In any case, any use that could cause damage to the honour, reputation or decorum of the person portrayed, filmed or recorded is excluded.</p> <p>The Data Controller does not use automatic processes aimed at profiling the interested party.</p>

Recipients of personal data and any transfers of data abroad</p>	<p>Within the limits relevant to the processing purposes indicated, the data will be communicated and/or in any case accessible to the employees of the Consortium and to any collaborators in the capacity of subjects authorized for the processing and to the other structures of the Consortium for institutional purposes or for compliance with legislative obligations.</p> <p>In the event that the data referred to in point 2 are transmitted to third parties who carry out processing on behalf of the CNIT Consortium, they will perform the function of Data Controllers, subject to an act of appointment pursuant to and for the purposes of Article 28 of the GDPR</p> <p>For the events indicated below, the data will be transmitted to: Fondazione Restart CF 96542900582, Via Cracovia n.50, 00133 Roma Ditta Immagini e Suoni, CF 03702750377, Via Guido Rossa n. 28,40033 Casalecchio di Reno (BO), responsible for the technical part of the virtual room on Zoom and the stream on YouTube</p>
<p>6. Storage times for personal data</p>	<p>The data collected will be retained for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are processed ("principle of limitation of storage", Article 5 of the GDPR) or in accordance with the deadlines stipulated by legal regulations.</p> <p>In particular, the images, audio and videos of the interested parties will be kept for ten years from the end of the event on the occasion of which they were collected.</p>
<p>7. Right of the data subject</p>	<p>The data subject has the right to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - request from the Controller (by emailing direzione@cnit.it), pursuant to Articles 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21 of the GDPR, access to his/her personal data and the rectification or deletion thereof or the restriction of the processing concerning him/her or to object to the processing thereof, in addition to the right to data portability; - lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (Garante Per La Protezione dei Dati Personali, Piazza Venezia 11, Rome, https://www.garanteprivacy.it) at e-mail address protocollo@gpdp.it or protocollo@pec.gpdp.it.
<p>8. Obligation to provide data</p>	<p>The provision of data is optional if not strictly related to the functioning of the activity carried out. Failure to consent will not allow the use of the images and/or audiovisual footage of the interested party for the purposes indicated above.</p>



9. Modalities of data processing	The personal data provided, will be subject to processing operations in compliance with the aforementioned legislation and with the confidentiality obligations that rule the Controller's activity. The data will be processed both by computer and on paper or any other suitable medium, in compliance with the appropriate security measures pursuant to Article 5(1)(f) of the GDPR.
10. Transfer of data abroad	Personal data may be transferred to third countries, in compliance with the provisions of Chapter V of the GDPR (articles 44-50).
